Though English speakers have many praise and worship albums to listen to, none have the Spanish touch as **PRAISE FROM SPAIN**. In the instrumentation of these songs, you get a sense of Spanish contemporary music that only a Spaniard could produce. While all of the songs do have English included in the lyrics, three songs are bilingual where the chorus with the same meaning is sung in Spanish.

Another beautiful addition to this work is the inclusion of 4 of the most beloved passages of scripture from the Bible. Lori's song, **FLAMENCO**, is a must to listen to. In this rhythmic tune you hear the flamenco percussion, guitars, and even the beautiful voices of gypsy friends that give this melody something few English speakers have had the chance to enjoy.
